

Parent information and consent: Short survey for young people

Evaluation of Te Tai Ohinga Youth Hub

Kia ora whānau, parents and caregivers,

We write to ask for your help.

Wellington City Council has asked an independent evaluation firm (Pragmatica) to review Te Tai Ohinga Youth Hub to understand the value it provides to young people.

Pragmatica are asking young people to complete a short survey about the value they get from coming to Te Tai Ohinga Youth Hub. Because your young person is under 14, we need your permission for them to take part.

- **What does this involve?** Your young person will be asked to complete a short paper-based survey. The survey will take about 5–10 minutes. It includes simple questions about their experiences and opinions. There are no right or wrong answers.
- **Confidentiality and privacy:** The survey is anonymous – they will not be asked for their name. Responses will be kept confidential. Completed surveys will be collected directly by the researcher, so others cannot see their answers. Information will be reported in a way that does not identify any person.
- **Voluntary participation:** Taking part is completely voluntary. Your young person can choose not to take part or skip any questions. They can stop at any time they choose.
- **Safety and support:** The questions are not sensitive, and your young person can stop at any time. Support, such as a reader/writer is available if wanted.
